



Cornerstone Nurseries Policy on using the nursery camera

Currently there are no nursery cameras at Cornerstone Day Nursery but photographs are taken using the Nursery tablets. Cornerstone Miss Muffet have a children's camera which is used to take and directly print photos that the children have taken.

The management team and marketing manager will sometimes use their own device in full view of other team members to take photographs and upload to the nursery computers for marketing and parent partnership purposes, however once uploaded or printed for use, they are deleted from devices. No employee will ever take photographs of a child without other staff present or keep photos on their devices.

We ask parents for their signed permission for us to take and display photos of their child/ren and for any photos to be used for marketing purposes, on our website or social media or by a third party (e.g. the local newspaper).

The children within the nursery have access to cameras via the tablets they use in play (please see policy on children using the internet and devices). Children never have unsupervised access to any cameras.
